

SELECTMEN'S MEETING – February 23, 2009

The Selectmen signed the warrants and they were posted with the Budget and Ordinance attached.

Mr. Aldrich stated that Mr. Bernstein had collected a great amount of good information. Mr. Aldrich questioned whether the Selectmen should dissolve the committee and they did not make a decision.

The Selectmen received a letter from the Town of Lisbon in regard to the Champagne property and the status of the two lots in Sugar Hill. The Selectmen have forwarded the information to Attorney Waugh for a legal opinion.

The Selectmen received two property abatement applications and will submit to the Assessor for review.

The Selectmen discussed information from Attorney Fulton in regard to a property abatement and will follow her advice in obtaining a verbal assessment.
