The Selectmen discussed painting or replacing the front door and also the possibility of replacing the old windows in the Crapo Building. No decision on the front door was made at this time.

The Selectmen reviewed a letter that the Conservation Commission has written to be sent to all property owners that border on Gale River, Coffin Pond and Streeter Pond.

Ms. Connors will follow up on getting information on ArcView software.

MR. HAYWARD met with the Selectmen to follow up on a letter that was sent to Barbara Serafini and Paul Hayward in regard to parking requirements for the Homestead and Annex property merger. The Selectmen have asked that at plan showing the proposed parking be made available.

The Selectmen signed the contract with Cartographic Associates for the mapping project that was approved at Town Meeting.
