SELECTMEN'S MEETING – July 19, 2010

Correspondence was read and acted upon.

The Selectmen will be meeting at 7:00 PM on July 26th.

The Selectmen will not meet on August 2, 2010.

BEVERLY FRENKIEWICH met with the Selectmen to advise the board that the SHIA would be interested in helping with the cost to repair the stone wall at the Crapo Building. The board is in the process of getting an estimate for the repair of the stone wall and will share the estimate with the SHIA.

The Selectmen reviewed a septic plan for Guy & Pamela Trag, Map 203, Lot 28.1.

The Selectmen approved a driveway permit for logging for Richard and James Hunt, Map 227, Lot 8. Jericho Road.

The Selectmen received a copy of a Tower Removal Bond that they had requested from NCIC to go with the lease agreement. The bond presented was for three years and the lease for five years. They will need to be adjusted to be the same time frame. All will be sent to the town attorney for review.

MS. CONNORS reported that she had received a complaint in regard to speeding on Blake Road and that will be shared with Chief Wentworth.

The Selectmen received letters from Littleton Regional Hospital and North Country Home Health thanking the Town for their donations as voted at the 2010 Town Meeting.

Mr. DE MAYO asked about the energy grant and the funding of street and traffic lights. Ms. Connors noted that the grant was for energy saving and replacing existing and not for new installations. MR. DE MAYO asked the Selectmen who to contact in regard to a blinking caution light or mirror at the intersection of Route 117 and Easton Road. The Selectmen advised that Route 117 falls under the jurisdiction of the State DOT – Lancaster office.

Jennifer notified the board that Chief Clark had reported an accident involving a test drive of a fire engine that did not belong to the town on Center District Road. There was some damage to the vehicle but no injuries. Road Agent Glover will be making the necessary repairs to the side of the road. The insurance claim will be on the dealership of the truck not the Town of Sugar Hill.

MR. STRASSER made a motion to accept the minutes of July 12th, 2010, seconded by MS. CONNORS. The motion was approved unanimously.
