

SELECTMEN'S MEETING – January 3, 2011

Correspondence was read and acted upon.

The Selectmen will not meet on Monday January 17, 2011 in observance of Martin Luther King Jr., Civil Rights Day.

CHIEF WENTWORTH introduced the board to ERIC VAUN HEFFLYUNN as the new part time officer for the department. Eric will be sworn in next Monday.

The Selectmen reviewed a septic plan for Jody & Crystal Hodgdon for Map 227, Lot 14.

The Selectmen approved an Intent to Cut Wood or Timber for Nicholas and Nicole DeMayo on Map 222, Lot 7.

The Administrative Assistant asked the Selectmen for specifics on the assessing bid. The Selectmen would like a price on a one year bid and also on a four year plan that would bring them to the new revaluation cycle in 2014.

The Administrative Assistant has contacted Franconia in regard to combining the Towns heating oil needs to try and get a better rate for fuel oil. The Selectmen will discuss at the Tri-Town meeting. Our Town Energy Alliance is available to municipalities. The cost to join is \$50.00 per year with an additional \$15.00 for each site. They would need the volume used and they can then negotiate to give us a price.

The Selectmen received a letter from Lon Henderson of Henderson Holdings in regard to insufficiencies in the town maintenance of the sidewalk on Sunset Hill Road. Currently the town does not maintain the sidewalks. Chairman Bielefield will meet with Road Agent Glover to put a plan in place and develop a policy to deal with sidewalk maintenance.

The Selectmen received a letter commending Sgt. Ball.

The Selectmen will send the Fire Chief's questions in regard to the plot plan for the NCIC Tower to Susan Wheeler for clarification.

The Selectmen will meet with the Franconia and Easton Selectboards on January 18, 2011 at 4:00PM to discuss the Tri Town Recreation and Tri Town Transfer Station budget.

MR. BIELEFIELD made a motion to accept the minutes of December 20, 2010, seconded by MR. STRASSER. The motion was approved unanimously.

MR. BIELEFIELD made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 6:30 PM, seconded by MR. BIELEFIELD. The next regular scheduled meeting will be on Monday, January 10, 2011 at the Carolina Crapo Building at 6:00PM.
