The Selectmen reviewed a building permit for Randall and Elizabeth Kunz to replace a barn and add a deck at 1495 Route 117. (Map 218, Lot 56) Setbacks are required and will notify the builder.

The building permit on file is incomplete and cannot be extended. In addition the request for a mobile home on the property is denied as they are not allowed in the General Residential District.

The application was received within the April 15 deadline and once it is complete it will be processed if the owner wishes. The Selectmen cannot hold the application until the Fucci's abatement application is processed as had been requested.

The Town Attorney Bernie Waugh presented his 2010 Municipal Law update.

The Selectmen discussed a current legal case with Town Attorney Waugh.
