Barbara Serafini presented the plans to the Board. It was noted that lot #2 on the plans and map # 219 Lot # 27.111 are to be merged and put into Paul Hayward's name. It was noted that she would need to go before the ZBA before for a special exception before moving forward with the Planning Board. John Strasser noted that legal counsel has advised that the ZBA needs to approve this subdivision under a special exception due to Section 402 of the Zoning Ordinance of Sugar Hill – Lots in Two Zoning Districts – describing that there shall be only 1 principal building on a lot used for residential purposes. Chairman Mike Hern of the Zoning Board will be notified and he will set up a hearing date for this special exception.

It was noted that Rob Hayward rejoined the Board.
