

## SELECTMEN'S MEETING – November 19, 2012

Correspondence was read and acted upon.

CHIEF WENTWORTH updated the board on a current welfare issue that he and Chief Clark are dealing with. The property has been banned and cannot be entered. The board also will ask Haley Ireland if she would be interested in the Health Officer position.

JOHN RUSSELL met with the board to express concerns with the condition of Scragg Mountain Road after recent work by Verizon. The board explained that they do not want the road upgraded but it must be returned to the condition that it was in prior to the excavation. The board will send a letter to Verizon restating the fact that the road must be left in the condition that it was found.

ROAD AGENT DOUG GLOVER met with the board and updated them on the condition of Scragg Mountain Road. Doug will continue to monitor the work on Scragg Mountain Road. The Crane Hill Bridge work is complete and done under the direction of Engineer Red McCarthy. The septic tank at the Highway Garage has been replaced and the funds will come from the Capital Reserve Fund. Doug will meet with Margo to look at where the fill is needed on Sunset Hill Road. Mr. Glover is also getting information of the possibility of a pre-cast bridge to replace Crane Hill Bridge. The Highway Committee has met and toured all the roads in town. Mr. Glover is pleased to have such a good committee to work with. Mr. Martland has provided a preliminary report of their findings.

The Board received a letter from Barbara Serafini in regard to the Hayward/Serafini property the Homestead and Annex. Ms. Serafini will go before the Planning Board to request the parcels be separated. The letter will be sent to Attorney Waugh.

Ms. Connors discussed with the Board the possibility of the Conservation Commission voting to use some of the Conservation Fund toward the Community Forest.

Ms. Connors notified the board that she had attended the hearing in Plymouth that discussed the feasibility of burying the power lines in existing ROW's.

MR. BIELEFIELD made a motion to approve the minutes of November 5, 2012, seconded by MR. STRASSER. The motion passed unanimously.

With no more business and no appointments before the Board, MR. STRASSER made a motion to adjourn; seconded by MS. CONNORS the meeting was adjourned at 7:15 PM.

The next regular scheduled meeting will be on Monday, November 26, 2012 at the Carolina Crapo Building at 6:00PM.
