The board reviewed an application for a building permit for a shed on Map 220, Lot 2 owned by Andrea Vandehoeck and Alan Laubenstein. The setback can't be met and a variance will be required. The Select board denied the Zoning Permit so that the owners may proceed to the Zoning Board of Adjustment.
