Accepted minutes of Feb 10 2017 meeting. There was no meeting for March 2017 RACHELLE LYONS reviewed stream crossings project for Town of Sugar Hill. See attached notes she supplied.

Ammonoosuc River stream crossing project assessed points at which a public road crossed a stream or river in Sugar Hill based on Geomorphic Compatibility - extent to which a culvert or bridge allows a natural flow of stream water and Aquatic Organism Compatibility - estimate of whether fish and other aquatic animals can move through the culvert.

They also estimated the probability that the culvert would withstand flood waters in the future. Sugar Hill did not rank well on any measure and is likely to suffer major damage in the next major rain event like Hurricane Irene. Many of our culverts are also preventing the natural extension of populations of trout and thus reduce recreation opportunities in the Town. On May 31 at the Tender Corp in Littleton there will be a workshop on funding opportunities for area towns to repair and upgrade stream crossings.

To proceed towns need to

(1) identify and prioritize projects

(2) do fine assessment using data set provided at NH SADES (Dept Trans.)

(3) coordinate Planning Board, Select Board, Road Agent, abutters and stakeholders who use the roads and Conservation Commission

(4) seek funding for long range capital improvement budget.
