SELECTMEN'S MEETING – November 2, 2015

Correspondence was read and acted upon.

No Select Board meeting on November 9, 2015 and the select board office will be closed the 10th and 12th of November.

The board reviewed the solar permit that the Town of Franconia is using and will use for a base for a Sugar Hill permit.

The board received a request from Davis Mangold, Ski Hearth Farm for a letter to be sent to the Society for the Protection of NH Forests in regard to operating the Nordic Center.

CHIEF WENTWORTH met with the board on police department business. Chief Wentworth updated the board on trailer they are putting together for the speed zone. Currently the part time officers are close to maxing out their time allowed by Police Standards and Training as they work in other communities. After the first of the year they will have more availability to fill in.

MARGO CONNORS reported that the sign for Coffin Pond must go to the State of review and will probably be a spring project. The sign per NH Fish and Game may only read Coffin Pond and not Joel S. Coffin Pond as had been discussed.

The board voted to use \$50,000 of the 2015 fund balance to offset taxes. The new rate will be \$21.33 which is .66 cents down from 2014.

The board will send a letter to the owners of the property located at 269 Sunset Hill Road to confirm whether a building permit is needed for work being done.

MS. CONNORS made a motion to approve the minutes of October 26, 2015, seconded by MR. BIELEFIELD. The motion passed unanimously.

With no more business and no appointments before the Board, MS. CONNORS made a motion to adjourn; seconded by MR. BIELEFIELD the meeting was adjourned at 6:00pm. The next regular scheduled meeting will be on Monday November 16, 2015 at the Carolina Crapo Building at 6:00 pm.
