

## SELECTMEN'S MEETING – April 27, 2015

Correspondence was read and acted upon.

The board discussed a request from a resident to have a piano loaned to the town for the Crapo Building. The board denied the request.

ROAD AGENT DOUG GLOVER met with the board to talk about the State Bridge Aid process. The process to hire an engineer will begin with an ad in the Courier this week. The request for qualification forms will be available in the Select Board's office. Qualification packages (4 copies) must be delivered to the Town by May 21, 2015. Road bans are still in place. The department is sweeping the roads and doing maintenance, painting in the shop. There were five street signs stolen last week. The highway crew and Pete Carbonneau all attended the recent chain saw safety class held at the Sugar Hill Fire Department. The new hot top trailer is working great and saving time in addition to producing a better product. Doug would like letters sent to several residents that need to replace driveway culverts.

The board discussed the Coffin Pond plan as designed by the forester and will get bids for the earthwork.
