Correspondence was read and acted upon.

The board will not meet on Memorial Day Monday May 30th.

Peter Grote, a Franconia representative on the Northern Pass Committee dropped off clarification on the Franconia Notch Chamber of Commerce position on the project. The Chamber does not support the Northern Pass Transmission Project as currently proposed.

The board approved a driveway permit for Stephen Burtchell, Map 219, Lot 11 on Birches Road.

CHIEF WENTWORTH discussed police department scheduling for June with the board. The Chief also discussed the parking at the Pioneer Wedding Barn on Saturday.
