The board signed petition/pole license for Eversource, Pole 115G/2 Pearl Lake Road.

The board reviewed abatements filed and discussed recommendations from the assessor in regard to the Sugar Hill Historical Museum and the former Homestead Property. The board denied the New England Telephone Abatement.
