

SELECTMEN'S MEETING – October 15, 2018

Correspondence was read and acted upon.

The board reviewed and pending Chief Clark's review approved a building permit for a new home for Christopher Monaco on Ski Pines Road, Map 220 Lot 3. The board will advise Mr. Monaco to have a survey done of his side line as his setback is close.

The board approved a steel storage building for James Dyckman on Valley Vista road, Map 204, Lot 6.11.

The board approves a building permit for Kathy Rehl on Trumpet round Road to enclose and existing deck into a three-season room. Map 230, Lot 17.

The board discussed the recent Northern Pass decision to be heard by the NH Supreme Court.

The board received a solar bid from O'Meara Solar for installation at the Town Garage for the Town Buildings. The board will solicit other bids.

The Town of Sugar Hill held a Public Hearing on Monday October 15th at 6:00 at the Carolina Crapo Building to discuss expending available unanticipated revenue received from FEMA for the July 2017 storm. After discussion it was a unanimous decision by the board that funds \$14,130.74 and \$81,952.45 would be placed for use in the Highway Department Roadwork Non-Lapsing Fund. Carl Martland shared the Road Committee's most recent report.

Carl Martland advised the board that the Town of Sugar Hill can appoint an additional commissioner to represent the town at the North Country Council. Mr. Strasser will advise the Planning Board.

MS. CONNORS made a motion to approve the minutes of October 1, 2018 meeting seconded by MR. STRASSER. The motion passed unanimously.

With no more business before the Board, MR. BIELEFIELD made a motion to adjourn; seconded by MS. CONNORS the meeting and hearing were adjourned at 6:45 PM. The next regular scheduled meeting will be on Monday October 22 2018, at the Carolina Crapo Building.
