SELECTMEN'S MEETING – March 25, 2019

Correspondence was read and acted upon.

The Town Clerk and Tax Collectors Office will be closed on March 26 and 28 and Sugar Hill registrations may be done in Franconia. The Franconia Office is open Wednesday 8-3, Thursday 10-6 and Friday 8-3.

The board signed a Current Use Change Tax with no penalty from 2004.

The board discussed possible dates for a joint meeting with Franconia and Easton to discuss the transfer station in light of the new equipment warrant article failing.

The board is still hoping to receive some bids for the revaluation process. Only one bid has been received to date.

The board received a letter from resident Doug Amsbary in regard to the purchase/lease of a new police vehicle. Mr. Amsbary is concerned that the Select Board cannot enter into a lease agreement and felt that the purchase of a new vehicle should have been discussed at Town Meeting. The board did have a discussion at the budget hearing in regard to the new vehicle and were ready to answer any questions at Town Meeting if they had been asked. There is no intention to lease a vehicle as the board did not do a warrant article for a lease.

Jake Poirier (Map 203, Lot 21) called to inquire about adding dormers to his house located on Streeter Pond drive. This property has already received a one-time 20% non-conforming expansion and the board will advise that adding dormers creates living space and a variance would be required.

MR. BIELEFIELD made a motion to approve the minutes of March 18, 2019, seconded by MR. STRASSER. The motion passed unanimously.

With no more business before the Board, MR. BIELEFIELD made a motion to adjourn. seconded by MS. CONNORS the meeting was adjourned at 6:35 PM. The next regular scheduled meeting will be on Monday April 1, 2019, at the Carolina Crapo Building at 6:00 PM.
