

SELECTMEN'S MEETING – June 15, 2020

Correspondence was read and acted upon.

The board will not be meeting on Monday June 22, 2020.

The board made the decision to not have a Fireworks display on July 4th. Perhaps later in the summer it may be possible.

The Crapo Building is closed to the public through the month of July; however, the Select Board will be meeting downstairs on Mondays with social distancing guidelines in place. The Town Clerk and Tax Collectors Office has a lock box at the front door you may leave renewals and tax payments in or they may be mailed.
