Correspondence was read and acted upon.

The Select Board will not meet on Monday August 10th, 2020.

The town offices are now open with normal business hours. The town was notified of a pending tower application on Route 3 in Twin Mountain.

The board approved a building permit for Christopher Labosky and Jennifer Downing for a new deck and a storage shed on Map 221, Lot 1. 229 Lafayette Road.

MS. CONNORS SPOKE WITH Maggie Steir in regard to possible grants for the Crane Hill Bridge Project. Ms. Steir will be in the area and will do a site visit to the bridge this weekend. It is too late for the LCHIP grant but perhaps the Moose Grant which is a maximum award of \$10,000.

Jennifer advised the board of the Highway Block award from NH DOT for the 2020-21 fiscal year. Money is down as expected from the previous year.

The board acted on a welfare request.

MS. CONNORS made a motion to approve the meeting minutes of July 27th, 2020 seconded by MR. STRASSER. The motion passed unanimously.
