The board received a letter from the Lang's who own property in Franconia and who have a right of way through their property to a piece in Sugar Hill. The Lang's wanted the Select Board to know they don approve and have not agreed with a recent proposal by Mr. Sabados the Sugar Hill property owner.

Jennifer advised the board that the Town Clerk's office received a 91A Right to Know Request in regard to the November 2020 election. Town Attorney Christine Fillmore will advise on the response. In addition, the Select Board office received a 91A request from NH Electric Coop that Jennifer will give to the assessor for a response.
