The June 18, 2015 Conservation Commission meeting will begin with a public hearing to discuss the expenditure of additional funds from the Conservation Fund to cover a cost overrun for the Trumpet Round parking area that accesses the Cooley-Jericho Community Forest. According to Town Engineer, Red McCarthy, the contractor hit "ledge" while creating the parking lot. Additional costs should not exceed \$1500.

On Wednesday, June 3, 2015, Profile High School class and teachers will clean up the Coffin Pond trail from 10 to 11:15. All are welcome to participate.

SHCC hopes to complete parking and drainage improvements to Coffin pond parking area in the next month as soon as DES and NH Fish and Game permits are reviewed and accepted.

It is the wish of the SHCC to sponsor a series of talks on wildlife in the North Country for the Lafayette Regional School in honor of Janeet Williams. Margo will follow up with school principal, Gordie Johnk.
