

SELECTMEN'S MEETING – March 15, 2021

Correspondence was read and acted upon.

- **Town Business Meeting will be held on May 11, 2021 at 6:00pm** at the **Sugar Hill Fire Station**. This will be a regular town meeting (although masks and social distancing will be required) where we will vote on warrant articles 3-18 which includes the 2021 budget. The Select Board will not meet on March 29, 2021.

The Select Board denied a Zoning Permit for Andrew & Caitlin Schuele for a new barn on their property at 999 Pearl Lake road as a variance is required due to it not meeting current set-backs. The paperwork will be given to the ZBA on Tuesday. Map 223, Lot 9

CHIEF HO-SING-LOY met with the board to discuss hiring a part time officer as Officer Emerson is no longer working. The board signed the hiring papers for Kelby Lewis.

The building permits for Clifford Hughes 207-9 and Laubenstein/Vandenheck 220-2 have conditions and will be completed and issued.

Jennifer advised that plans have gone to Chief Clark for the Morley Barn on Lafayette Road.

Residents of the Tri Towns may order compost bins by April 22 with pick up on May 15th at the Transfer Station. Information is on the website and FB page and also at the Crapo Building.

Jennifer updated the board on the request from Certified Computers to join MS-ISAC a municipal group that is constantly monitoring virus and other hackers.

After several inspections by Chief Clark, Select Board chair John Strasser signed a certificate of occupancy for the Pardo property on Streeter Pond Drive. Map 202, Lot 10.

The board received a written update from Town Engineer Red McCarthy on both the Crane Hill Bridge and Indian Brook projects.

MARGO CONNORS update the board on the Grafton County Broadband and information is up on the website and FB page. There is a survey, residents can take for the county. Margo also reported on the broadband zoom meeting with Nick Coates the Bristol Town Manager.

MR. STRASSER made a motion to approve the meeting minutes of March 8, 2021, seconded by MS. CONNORS. The motion passed unanimously.
