

SELECTMEN'S MEETING – January 10, 2022

Correspondence was read and acted upon.

The board reviewed an amended septic plan for Mark & Amy Venezia Map 227, Lot 23

The board reviewed a septic plan for Andre Aubin Map 210, Lot 10

MS CONNORS made a motion to request broadband coverage information to identify unserved locations in the Town as defined by NH RSA 38:38, I(c) seconded by MR. ELLMS. The motion passed unanimously.

The board agreed to write a letter to NHDOT in support of the Whitefield Conservation Commission in their opposition to granting Driveway Permit #14656 (GSL Landfill Development)

The Pine Hill Singers asked if they would be allowed to use the Crapo Building with procedures in place and the board approved the use.

The Willing Worker's reserved the first Thursday of each month for lunch/work meetings.

The board signed the ambulance contract with the Town of Littleton.

The board and administrative assistant signed the NH DRA forms MS60W and MS 60A.

CHIEF HO-SING-LOY met with the board in regard to hiring a new part time officer. Officer Kerry Pomeroy has been working part time in Franconia and the Chief would like to hire him. Officer Kelby Lewis has left the PD as he relocated out of the area.

The board received a request from Pemi-Baker Community Health in regard to funding for the 2022 year as they are now working in this area with Littleton Regional. Margo will follow up and get additional information but the board does not see funding at this time.

MR. BIELEFIELD made a motion to approve the minutes of January 3, 2022 seconded by MS. CONNORS. The motion passed unanimously.
