

SELECTMEN'S MEETING– March 28, 2022

Correspondence was read and acted upon.

Road Bans are on all town roads. Questions contact the Road Agent 823-8788.

Broadband Committee will hold a hearing on Monday April 25th at 6:00pm at the Crapo Building to discuss the broadband information and current mapping of Sugar Hill.

CHIEF HO-SING-LOY met with the board and updated them on scheduling and discussed creating an equipment capital reserve fund next year. This would be separate from the current capital reserve fund used for vehicle replacement. The Chief also explained to the board the new software the police will be using and that they recently trained for. One of the PD Computer's has failed and will need to be replaced.

Jennifer reported that she had spoken with Franconia Town Administrator Kim Cowles and that there are issues with some contractors and their dumping at the transfer station. The board felt a letter reiterating the costs and policies, handed out to all contractors using the transfer station may help. In addition, the board agreed that there needs to be better signage at the transfer station.

The board issued a certificate of occupancy for Clifford Hughes Map 207 Lot 9 for an apartment that has been completed.

The board reviewed a septic plan for Greg Dorsey Map 218, Lot 70.1.

Jennifer is working with David Wiley on the Mason and Godbout building permits.

The board signed an appointment sheet for Jordan Applewhite to be assistant to the Supervisors of the checklist.

The board accepted with regret the resignation of Terry Fowler from the Library Trustees. The board will request the remaining trustees make a recommendation for replacement until town meeting 2023.

CHIEF CLARK, ROAD AGENT GLOVER and JENNIFER met this morning to finalize figures that are to be submitted by the state to FEMA.

ROAD AGENT GLOVER has been working to see if DES will allow the town to remove the gravel bars from the Gale River as has been done in the past. At this time, it does not appear that they are in favor of the town doing this. More follow up will be done.

MR. BIELEFIELD made a motion to approve the minutes of March 21, 2022 seconded by MR. ELLMS. The motion passed unanimously.

With no more business before the Board MS. CONNORS made a motion to adjourn, seconded by MR. BIELEFIELD the meeting was adjourned at 6:00 PM. The next regular scheduled meeting is Monday April 4, 2022 at the Carolina Crapo Building at 5:00 pm.
