Correspondence was read and acted upon.

The board will host a Tri Town Select Board Meeting on June 13th @ 4:00pm at the Crapo Building to discuss the Tri Town Transfer Station.

The Select Board Office will be closed on May 12, 2022.

CHRIS ELLMS reported on his conversation with Eversource Representative Catalina Celentano who is the community relations specialist for Sugar Hill. Eversource is not involved with the broadband unless at some point if the broadband supplier were to request to use Eversource poles. The Broadband Committee will work with a subcommittee on pole visibility.

Town of Franconia will be replacing the skid steer for the Tri Town Transfer Station and Sugar Hill's portion is \$10,616.70.

Jennifer filed the ARPA information and second payment of funds is expected sometime in July.

The new solar installation continues to work well for the town.

The board is looking to fill both spots on the Tri Town Recreation Committee.
