It was decided that we would respond as individuals rather than a group, more bang for the buck. It also will allow a quicker response.

JUDY presented 3 Intent to Cut applications; Blake Road, Toad Hill and Center District Road.

CLAIRE was asked about the Community Power program meeting and she told us no meeting was planned. CHRIS will look into this for us.
