

SELECTMEN'S MEETING– March 2, 2026

MR. ELLMS made a motion to approve the meeting minutes of February 24, 2026, seconded by MR. BIELEFIELD. The motion passed unanimously.

Correspondence was read and acted upon.

The board received the latest U199 updates. Work is now complete in Sugar Hill although they will be continuing their environmental monitoring and back in the spring to replace the culvert off Streeter Pond Road.

Town Engineer Red McCarthy would like to have a formal acknowledgement of the teachers and students at Lafayette School for their work on the Crane Hill Bridge Cultural Resource Project.

The Road Agent would like to contact a property owner on Streeter Pond Road regarding the snow sliding off the barn roof and filling the roadway. The board had no problem with Doug reaching out.

The board reviewed material provided by the Town Attorney for Access to a Condemned property in Sugar Hill. The Health Officer will notify the Road Agent when they would like the property to be opened.

The Building Officer Doug Amsbary submitted an information sheet on Monolithic Foundations, and we will include the information with our building regulations.

The board reminded those in attendance that the Planning Board meeting on Wednesday for the Split Rock subdivision and Planning & Zoning on Thursday for the cell tower variance.

The board took a short break from 5:18 until 5:30.

JAMES SNYDER met with the board to review the warrant for town meeting. One note suggested was in the future the tax implication should be listed as an estimated tax impact.

Mr. Snyder was asked if he would consider being the Deputy Town Moderator as there are two additional elections after Town Meeting, the new moderator will need to make the appointment. We will contact Mr. Egan who is running for Moderator to see if he can stop in next Monday.

Mr. Snyder will come in next week as well.
