Approval of the Minutes

Sexton's Report

- Cleaning headstones: D2 is the product we tested last year and were happy with the results. It's nontoxic and non-corrosive. We need to decide whether to take on the work ourselves, organize a volunteer event, or hire out the work. We have plenty on hand to use this summer if the opportunity presents itself. It was also confirmed that individual plot owners have the right to clean their personal family stones.
- New fencing: Peter will go pick it up when he has the opportunity to do so.
- Flags: ready to install when it's time.

Old Business

- Warrant Article: The article did pass at town meeting, so we now have a capital reserve fund for infrastructure projects. It is not intended for maintenance.
- George Howland Rev. War status: LK will follow up with his descendant for more info.
- Sunnyside maps: LK is in the process of creating one map from the seven section maps we have on hand.
- Green burials: the committee discussed the new Oliverian Everlasting Burial Ground, located in Benton. It is a 29-acre independent cemetery owned and operated by White Mountain Conservation Burial (a non-profit organization). It is open to the public and a good resource for anyone interested in green burials in the local area.

New Business

- Budget review & 2026 priorities
 - Hannah/Streeter District: ledge pack to be spread over the existing gravel. Peter is working on sources.
 - Monument repair: 10-12 monuments need to be repaired. Littleton Monument will do the work. Peter has been in touch.
 - Monument cleaning: (see discussion above)
 - Signage: Dan Kenerson has given Peter an estimate and Peter will follow up.

- Shed: Peter will connect with the roofing contractor whose bid included more comprehensive work, and Peter will paint the shed himself.
- Memorial Day – Peter will reach out to the VFW regarding a service. The flags will be distributed mid-May.
